These are part-time programs. We encourage cultural diversity and welcome all ethnicities. We provide children with a positive sense of themselves and to build knowledge of their culture. Due to the focus on cultural immersion, parents are expected to be actively involved in the program - with cultural learning and the family support outreach worker.

This program is designed with 5 main components based on the Wet'suwet'en Wellness Conceptual Framework, developed by the Wet'suwet'en Wellness Working Group:

- Being seen, being heard
- Social responsibility
- Spirituality
- Sustainable livelihood
- Strengths

Your babies and pre-schoolers will be learning Wet'suwet'en language, songs, and culture to promote strong social, emotional, cognitive and physical development.
