The Wet'suwet'en Treaty Office Society has signed promissory notes and First Nation Negotiation Support Agreements totalling \$5,836,721 as at March 31, 2001, (\$4,505,557 as at March 31, 2000), representing advances made by Indian and Northern Affairs Canada for negotiations. Repayment provisions for those loans are outlined in Section 13.0 and 14.0 of the First Nation Negotiation Support Agreement.
